The role, for 6 months initially, will seek to:

- Provide a welcome visit once families arrive to introduce the support from within communities and regular contact following that first visit to ensure support and assistance is in place, to signpost to services and to report any concerns
- Arrange practical and emotional support to families and individuals who may have complex needs to enable them to adapt to life in the UK
- Support the voluntary and community sector where needed in delivering their offer including financial support, networking and drop in sessions, child and parent support
- Be aware of opportunities to increase the offer from the community to host families and Ukrainian families and work with CVS team to support the development of that offer
- Work closely with Teignbridge District Council and Devon County Council in keeping up to date with legislation and opportunity and to feedback patterns, needs and detail as required from the Teignbridge area
- Deliver the support to all individuals and host families fairly and without discrimination
