1. No new items had been reported to the Clerk for this month. So, we revisited some of the outstanding items.
2. B3212 – depression marked up last month is fading. Ines will remark and chase to see where it is on the list. **Action Ines**
3. Ines will also do the same as above for the Sowton Bridge Road reported last month. **Action Ines**
4. The Clerk informed Ines of the meeting she attended with Devon Association of Local Councils and Highways Officers. This group has been formed to improve communication between the two groups. Dunsford was pleased to be able to report that they have a good working relationship with their Highways Officer.
5. Ines was informed that the Clerk and some Cllrs are attending a webinar on 15th August entitled 'An introduction to self - help Highways schemes'
6. Ines informed the Clerk that the Lea Lane works has been allocated monies to investigate the problem of flooding at the junction of the B3212.
7. The Clerk had been made aware of some scaffolding in the Village that was blocking the pathway. We visited the area and spoke to the workman but it had already been cleared.
8. **It is important to keep reporting any potholes that fit the criteria of a defect as these will be dealt with. The Clerk will keep advertising the link to do this.**
